Rim BAYAA holds a Ph.D in Biology from the University of Claude Bernard-Lyon 1 in 2022. Her work focused on the development and clinical evaluation of new blood-based tests for improving the diagnosis of pulmonary tuberculosis and identification of candidate biomarkers for treatment monitoring. Currently, Rim is a postdoctoral researcher at Hospices Civils de Lyon, and she is working on APRECIT-BIS project which is a collaboration with the Medical and Scientific Department (DMS), Fondation Mérieux in France. In this project, she focuses on the improvement of the management of tuberculosis infection in high incidence settings. She is essentially engaged in actions whose primary intent is to improve health, and to support vulnerable groups and refugees in their camps.
